## **SENATE BILL NO. 318**

May 20, 2025, Introduced by Senators SANTANA, IRWIN, BAYER, CAVANAGH, SHINK, CHANG, GEISS and DAMOOSE and referred to Committee on Finance, Insurance, and Consumer Protection.

A bill to amend 1953 PA 232, entitled "Corrections code of 1953,"

by amending section 67a (MCL 791.267a), as added by 1996 PA 234.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 67a. (1) A prisoner who receives nonemergency medical,
- 2 dental, or optometric services at his or her request is responsible
- 3 for a copayment fee to the department for those services, as
- 4 determined by the department. If the prisoner is a minor, the
- 5 prisoner's parent or guardian is also responsible for a copayment
- 6 fee imposed under this section.

- 1 (1) (2) A prisoner who intentionally injures himself or
  2 herself, and receives emergency medical care for that injury, is
  3 responsible for the entire cost of the medical care. , rather than
  4 the copayment described in subsection (1).
- 5 (2) (3)—The department shall determine whether those prisoners 6 who injure themselves intentionally shall—will be housed in a 7 facility designed to allow on-site medical treatment of those 8 injuries. Not later than 6 months after the effective date of this 9 section, September 30, 1997, the director of the department shall 10 report to the legislature on the feasibility and cost of
