## **SENATE BILL NO. 348**

May 29, 2025, Introduced by Senator BUMSTEAD and referred to Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to amend 1923 PA 238, entitled

"An act authorizing the formation of corporations for the purpose of generating, manufacturing, producing, gathering, storing, transmitting, distributing, transforming, selling and supplying electric energy or gas, either artificial or natural, or both electric energy and gas, to the public generally, or to public utilities or natural gas companies, and providing for and giving to such corporations and also to corporations heretofore lawfully organized, among other things, for such purposes; to corporations heretofore lawfully organized, or that may hereafter be lawfully organized and duly authorized to carry on the electric or gas business as a public utility in the state of Michigan; and to foreign corporations heretofore lawfully organized or that may

hereafter be lawfully organized, among other things, for such purposes, and duly authorized to carry on business in the state of Michigan, the right to condemn private property for the uses provided for herein,"

by amending section 5 (MCL 486.255), as added by 2004 PA 197.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 5. (1) Subject to the electric transmission line
- 2 certification act, 1995 PA 30, MCL 460.561 to 460.575, and the
- 3 uniform condemnation procedures act, 1980 PA 87, MCL 213.51 to
- 4 213.75, an independent transmission company or an affiliated
- 5 transmission company shall have has the power to condemn property
- 6 that is necessary to transmit electric energy for public use except
- 7 for both of the following:
- 8 (a) An independent transmission company or affiliated
- 9 transmission company shall not circumvent a private agreement that
- 10 existed on the effective date of the amendatory act that added this
- 11 subsection July 12, 2004 under which the independent transmission
- 12 company or affiliated transmission company leases rights-of-way for
- 13 its electric transmission facilities from the utility.
- 14 (b) An independent transmission company or affiliated
- 15 transmission company shall not condemn property owned by an
- 16 electric or gas utility or municipally owned utility in a manner
- 17 which that unreasonably disrupts the ability of the electric or gas
- 18 utility or municipally owned utility to continue to provide service
- 19 to its customers. If a dispute exists under this subdivision, the
- 20 condemnation shall must not proceed until the Michigan public
- 21 service—commission determines that no unreasonable disruption is
- 22 involved. The commission shall make its a determination under this
- 23 subdivision pursuant to in accordance with a contested case under
- 24 the administrative procedures act of 1969, 1969 PA 306, MCL 24.201

- 1 to 24.328, within not later than 180 days of after the date an
- 2 application or petition requesting a determination is filed with
- 3 the commission. If the principal parties of record agree that the
- 4 complexity of dispute involved requires additional time, the
- 5 commission may have has up to 210 days from the date the
- 6 application or petition was filed to make a determination under
- 7 this subdivision.
- 8 (2) Except as otherwise provided under this section, in
- 9 condemning property under subsection (1), an independent
- 10 transmission company or affiliated transmission company is subject
- 11 to the same procedures and requirements under this act as a
- 12 corporation formed under this act.
- 13 (3) Section 3(1) and any procedure or requirement under this
- 14 act that is inconsistent with the electric transmission line
- 15 certification act, 1995 PA 30, MCL 460.561 to 460.575, or the
- 16 uniform condemnation procedures act, 1980 PA 87, MCL 213.51 to
- 17 213.75, do not apply to an independent transmission company or
- 18 affiliated transmission company.
- 19 (4) As used in this act:
- 20 (a) "Affiliated transmission company" means a either of the
- 21 following:
- 22 (i) A person, partnership, corporation, association, or other
- 23 legal entity, or its successors or assigns, which that has fully
- 24 satisfied the requirements to join a regional transmission
- 25 organization, as determined by the federal energy regulatory
- 26 commission, that is engaged in this state in the transmission of
- 27 electricity using facilities it owns, that were transferred to the
- 28 entity by an electric utility that was engaged in the generation,
- 29 transmission, and distribution of electricity in this state on

- 1 December 31, 2000, and that is not independent of an electric
- 2 utility or an affiliate of the utility, generating or distributing
- 3 electricity to retail customers in this state.
- 4 (ii) A person, partnership, corporation, association, or other
- 5 legal entity, or its successors or assigns, that holds a
- 6 certificate issued by the commission under the electric
- 7 transmission line certification act, 1995 PA 30, MCL 460.561 to
- 8 460.575, if that entity is an affiliate of an electric utility
- 9 generating or distributing electricity to retail customers in this
- 10 state.
- 11 (b) "Commission" means the Michigan public service commission.
- 12 (c) (b) "Independent transmission company" means a either of
- 13 the following:
- 14 (i) A person, partnership, corporation, association, or other
- 15 legal entity, or its successors or assigns, that has fully
- 16 satisfied the requirements to join a regional transmission
- 17 organization and that is engaged in this state in the transmission
- 18 of electricity using facilities it owns, that have been divested to
- 19 the entity by an electric utility that was engaged in the
- 20 generation, transmission, and distribution of electricity in this
- 21 state on December 31, 2000, and is independent of an electric
- 22 utility or if that entity is not an affiliate of the an electric
- 23 utility —generating or distributing electricity to retail
- 24 customers in this state.
- 25 (ii) A person, partnership, corporation, association, or other
- 26 legal entity, or its successors or assigns, that holds a
- 27 certification issued by the commission under the electric
- 28 transmission line certification act, 1995 PA 30, MCL 460.561 to
- 29 460.575, if that entity is not an affiliate of an electric utility

- 1 generating or distributing electricity to retail customers in this
  2 state.
- 3 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 4 unless all of the following bills of the 103rd Legislature are
- 5 enacted into law.
