## **SENATE BILL NO. 384**

June 10, 2025, Introduced by Senator ANTHONY and referred to Committee on Health Policy.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

by amending section 17745a (MCL 333.17745a), as amended by 2016 PA 379.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 17745a. (1) As used in this section:
- 2 (a) "Medicaid" means the program of medical assistance
- 3 established under title XIX of the social security act, 42 USC 1396
- 4 to  $\frac{1396w-5.1396w-8}{1396w-8}$

- 1 (b) "Medicare" means the federal Medicare program established
  2 under title XVIII of the social security act, 42 USC 1395 to 1395lll.
- 3 (c) "Public health program" means 1 of the following:
- $\mathbf{4}$  (i) A local health department.
- 5 (ii) A migrant health center or a community health center as
  6 that term is defined under 42 USC 254b. and 254c.
- 7 (iii) A family planning program designated by the department of
  8 health and human services as a provider type 23 under the social
  9 welfare act, 1939 PA 280, MCL 400.1 to 400.119b, and verified by
  10 the department of health and human services.
- 11 (iv) A methadone treatment program licensed under article 6.
- 12 (v) A rural health clinic.
- (vi) A hospice rendering emergency care services in a patient'shome as described in section 17746.
- 15  $(v\ddot{u})$  A county jail if the county jail provides medical care to 16 inmates.
- 17 (d) "Rural health clinic" means a rural health clinic as that
  18 term is defined in section 42 USC 1395x that is certified to
  19 participate in Medicaid and Medicare.
- 20 (2) Except as otherwise provided in subsections (3) and (4)
  21 and subject to subsection (5), in a public health program without
  22 an on-site pharmacy, a dispensing prescriber may delegate the
  23 dispensing of prescription drugs only to a registered professional
  24 nurse licensed under part 172.
- (3) In Except as otherwise provided in subsections (4) and (5), in a public health program without an on-site pharmacy, a dispensing prescriber may delegate the delivery of prescription drugs consisting only of prelabeled, prepackaged oral
- 29 contraceptives under the following circumstances:

- (a) The delivery is delegated to an appropriately trained
   individual.
- 3 (b) The delivery is performed pursuant to specific, written4 protocols.
- (4) In a methadone treatment program licensed under article 6
  without an on-site pharmacy, a dispensing prescriber may delegate
  the delivery of a prescription drug consisting only of 1 or more
  single doses of methadone, up to the maximum number of single doses
  allowed by law, to a registered client of the methadone treatment
  program, if all of the following requirements are met:
- (a) The delivery is delegated to a registered professionalnurse or a licensed practical nurse licensed under part 172.
- 13 (b) The delivery is performed pursuant to specific, written14 protocols.
- (c) The prescription drug described in this subsection islabeled in accordance with section 17745.
  - (5) In a county jail described in subsection (1) (c) (vii), a dispensing prescriber who is under contract with the county jail may delegate the delivery of prescription drugs associated with a medically assisted treatment program if any of the following apply:
  - (a) The delivery is to an inmate of the county jail.
  - (b) If an inmate of the county jail is being released from the custodial environment of the county jail, the delivery of the prescription drug is to the inmate and consists of a quantity that will provide the inmate with not more than a 30-day supply of the prescription drug.
