SENATE BILL NO. 390

June 10, 2025, Introduced by Senator SINGH and referred to Committee on Civil Rights, Judiciary, and Public Safety.

A bill to amend 1961 PA 236, entitled "Revised judicature act of 1961,"

(MCL 600.101 to 600.9947) by adding section 2980.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 2980. (1) A person is liable to the owner or handler of a
- 2 service animal for damages that result from an injury to the
- 3 service animal, including, but not limited to, the death of the
- 4 service animal, that is caused by the person or by an animal owned
- 5 by the person.

- 1 (2) All of the following may be awarded as damages in an 2 action brought under this section:
- 3 (a) Economic damages, including, but not limited to, all of 4 the following:
- 5 (i) The value of the service animal if the service animal is 6 killed or is not able to do its work or perform its tasks.
- 7 (ii) The value of any equipment associated with the service 8 animal that was damaged, including, if available, the replacement 9 cost of new equipment.
- 10 (iii) The reasonable cost of care for the service animal, 11 including, but not limited to, all of the following:
- 12 (A) Transportation expenses.
- (B) Loss of the owner's or handler's earnings.
- 14 (C) Travel and lodging expenses.
- 15 (D) Veterinary expenses.
- 16 (E) Expenses of necessary substances and products.
- 17 (F) Hospitalization or boarding expenses.
- 18 (iv) The reasonable cost of retraining or rehabilitating the 19 service animal.
- 20 (v) The reasonable cost of replacing the service animal, if 21 necessary, including, but not limited to, all of the following:
- 22 (A) The cost of locating the replacement animal.
- 23 (B) Travel and lodging expenses.
- 24 (C) Loss of the owner's or handler's earnings.
- 25 (D) Cost of the replacement animal.
- 26 (E) The expense of transporting the replacement animal.
- 27 (F) Training expenses.
- 28 (b) Punitive damages if the conduct of the liable person was 29 intentional or reckless.

- 1 (c) Attorney fees and actual costs.
- 2 (3) A person is liable under this section whether the conduct 3 that caused the injury was intentional, reckless, or negligent.
- 4 (4) This section does not affect the right to any other remedy
 5 available to the owner or handler of the service animal under any
 6 other law.
- 7 (5) As used in this section, "service animal" means that term 8 as defined in section 50a of the Michigan penal code, 1931 PA 328, 9 MCL 750.50a.
