## **SENATE BILL NO. 395**

June 10, 2025, Introduced by Senator BELLINO and referred to Committee on Energy and Environment.

A bill to amend 1929 PA 16, entitled

"An act to regulate the business of carrying or transporting, buying, selling, or dealing in crude oil or petroleum or its products, or certain substances consisting primarily of carbon dioxide through pipe lines; to authorize the use of public highways and the condemnation of private property; to regulate the purchase and storage of crude oil or petroleum or certain substances consisting primarily of carbon dioxide; to provide for the control and regulation of all corporations, associations, and persons engaged in such business, by the Michigan public service commission; to define the powers and duties of the commission in relation thereto; and to prescribe penalties,"

by amending section 1 (MCL 483.1), as amended by 2014 PA 85.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. (1) As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Carbon dioxide substance" means a gaseous or liquid
- 3 substance, consisting primarily of carbon dioxide, that will be put
- 4 in storage or that has been or will be used to produce hydrocarbons
- 5 in a secondary or enhanced recovery operation.
- 6 (b) "Commission" means the Michigan public service commission.
- 7 (c) "Person" means an individual, partnership, corporation,
- 8 association, governmental entity, or other legal entity.
- 9 (2) A person exercising or claiming the right to carry or
- 10 transport crude oil or petroleum, or any of the products thereof,
- 11 or carbon dioxide substances, by or through pipe line or lines, for
- 12 hire, compensation or otherwise, or exercising or claiming the
- 13 right to engage in the business of piping, transporting, or storing
- 14 crude oil or petroleum, or any of the products thereof, or carbon
- 15 dioxide substances, or engaging in the business of buying, selling,
- 16 or dealing in crude oil or petroleum or carbon dioxide substances
- 17 within this state, does not have or possess the right to conduct or
- 18 engage in the business or operations, in whole or in part, or have
- 19 or possess the right to locate, maintain, or operate the necessary
- 20 pipe lines, fixtures, and equipment belonging to, or used in
- 21 connection with that business on, over, along, across, through, in
- 22 or under any present or future highway, or part thereof, or
- 23 elsewhere, within this state, or have or possess the right of
- 24 eminent domain, or any other right, concerning the business or
- 25 operations, in whole or in part, except as authorized by and
- 26 subject to this act.
- 27 (3) Subsection (2) does not apply to a either of the
- 28 following:

(a) A right that exists on March 27, 1929 and is valid, 1 2 vested, and incapable of revocation by any law of this state or of 3 the United States. 4 (b) The operation of a carbon sequestration well under part 651 of the natural resources and environmental protection act, 1994 5 PA 451, MCL 324.65101 to 324.65116. 6 7 Enacting section 1.
