SENATE BILL NO. 405

June 11, 2025, Introduced by Senators CAMILLERI, HERTEL and SANTANA and referred to Committee on Health Policy.

A bill to amend 2019 PA 39, entitled "Administration of opioid antagonists act," by amending section 101 (MCL 15.671).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 101. (1) This act shall be known and may be cited as the 2 "administration of opioid antagonists act".
- 3 (2) As used in this act:
- 4 (a) "Agency" means a governmental agency.
- 5 (b) "Employee or agent" means any of the following:

- (i) An individual who is employed by, or under contract with,
 an agency.
- $oldsymbol{3}$ (ii) An individual who serves on the governing body of an $oldsymbol{4}$ agency.
- 5 (iii) An individual who volunteers with an agency.
- 6 (c) "Governmental agency" means this state or a political
 7 subdivision. but Governmental agency does not include a any of the
 8 following:
- 9 (i) A person licensed under part 209 of the public health code,10 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.20901 to 333.20979.
- 11 (ii) The board of a school district or intermediate school 12 district or the board of directors of a public school academy.
 - (d) "Intermediate school district" means that term as defined in section 4 of the revised school code, 1976 PA 451, MCL 380.4.
- 15 (e) (d) "Municipal corporation" means a city, village, or
 16 township or a combination of 2 or more of these when acting
 17 jointly.
- 18 (f) (e) "Opioid antagonist" means naloxone hydrochloride or
 19 any other similarly acting and equally safe drug approved by the
 20 United States Food and Drug Administration for the treatment of
 21 drug overdose.
- (g) (f) "Opioid-related overdose" means a condition,
 including, but not limited to, extreme physical illness, decreased
 level of consciousness, respiratory depression, coma, or death,
 that results from the consumption or use of an opioid or another
 substance with which an opioid was combined or that a reasonable
 person would believe to be an opioid-related overdose that requires
 medical assistance.
- (h) (g) "Political subdivision" means a municipal corporation,

- 1 county, county road commission, school district, community college
- 2 district, public library, port district, metropolitan district, or
- 3 transportation authority or a combination of 2 or more of these
- 4 when acting jointly; a district or authority authorized by law or
- 5 formed by 1 or more political subdivisions; or an agency,
- 6 department, court, board, or council of a political subdivision.
- 7 (i) "Public school academy" means that term as defined in
- 8 section 5 of the revised school code, 1976 PA 451, MCL 380.5.
- 9 (j) "School district" means that term as defined in section 6 10 of the revised school code, 1976 PA 451, MCL 380.6.
- 11 (k) (h) "State" means this state and its agencies,
- 12 departments, commissions, courts, boards, councils, and statutorily
- 13 created task forces. State includes a public university or college
- 14 of this state, whether established as a constitutional corporation
- 15 or otherwise.
- 16 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 17 unless Senate Bill No. 404 of the 103rd Legislature is enacted into
- **18** law.
