

# SENATE BILL NO. 433

June 24, 2025, Introduced by Senators POLEHANKI, BAYER and CHANG and referred to Committee on Education.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled  
"The revised school code,"  
(MCL 380.1 to 380.1852) by adding section 1509.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Sec. 1509. (1) By not later than July 1, 2026, the department  
2 of health and human services shall develop, and provide to the  
3 department, an informational notice in English, Spanish, and  
4 Arabic, containing information on the dangers of high-potency THC  
5 cannabis products and vaping and resources to support prevention

1 and treatment. The department shall provide the notice developed  
2 under this subsection to public schools and nonpublic schools and  
3 post the notice on the department's website.

4 (2) The department of health and human services shall annually  
5 update the informational notice developed under subsection (1) to  
6 account for any changes in health education or medical research  
7 related to the dangers of high-potency THC cannabis products and  
8 vaping, and shall provide the updated notice to the department by  
9 not later than July 1 of each year. The department shall provide  
10 the updated notice described in this subsection to public schools  
11 and nonpublic schools and post the updated notice on the  
12 department's website.

13 (3) Beginning with the 2026-2027 school year, the board of a  
14 school district or intermediate school district, board of directors  
15 of a public school academy, or governing body of a nonpublic school  
16 shall ensure that the informational notices described in  
17 subsections (1) and (2), as applicable, are provided to the parent  
18 or legal guardian of each pupil enrolled in the school district,  
19 intermediate school district, public school academy, or nonpublic  
20 school by not later than October 1 of each year.

21 (4) Beginning with the 2026-2027 school year, the board of a  
22 school district or intermediate school district, board of directors  
23 of a public school academy, or governing body of a nonpublic school  
24 shall post a link to the department webpage described in  
25 subsections (1) and (2) on the website of the school district,  
26 intermediate school district, public school academy, or nonpublic  
27 school.

28 (5) An informational notice described in this section may be  
29 sent electronically or by mail.

1           (6) The department, the department of health and human  
2 services, a school district, an intermediate school district, a  
3 public school academy, a nonpublic school, and any officers, board  
4 members, or employees of those institutions are immune from civil  
5 liability, both personally and professionally, for any damages  
6 allegedly caused by, arising out of, or relating to the  
7 informational notice developed under this section.

8           (7) As used in this section:

9           (a) "THC" means that term as defined in section 3 of the  
10 Michigan Regulation and Taxation of Marihuana Act, 2018 IL 1, MCL  
11 333.27953.

12           (b) "Vaping" means the use of a vapor product as that term is  
13 defined in section 4 of the youth tobacco act, 1915 PA 31, MCL  
14 722.644.
