## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1m. (1) A person is exempt from the licensure provisions of this act as provided for in subsection (2) if the person files an affidavit with the department that affirms all of the following:
- 4 (a) Before the effective date of the amendatory act that added 5 this section, the person lawfully sold a nicotine or tobacco

product at retail. 1 2 (b) An application under section 1e has been submitted for the 3 person and the application is pending department approval. 4 (c) The person has not been granted a license. (2) A person's exemption under subsection (1) expires when the 5 6 person's application under section le is no longer pending 7 department approval. 8 Enacting section 1.
