

# SENATE BILL NO. 465

June 26, 2025, Introduced by Senators BELLINO, SINGH, CAVANAGH, CHERRY, CHANG, WOJNO, POLEHANKI and BAYER and referred to Committee on Regulatory Affairs.

A bill to amend 1915 PA 31, entitled  
"Youth tobacco act,"  
(MCL 722.641 to 722.645) by adding section 1m.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Sec. 1m. (1) A person is exempt from the licensure provisions  
2 of this act as provided for in subsection (2) if the person files  
3 an affidavit with the department that affirms all of the following:  
4       (a) Before the effective date of the amendatory act that added  
5 this section, the person lawfully sold a nicotine or tobacco

1 product at retail.

2 (b) An application under section 1e has been submitted for the  
3 person and the application is pending department approval.

4 (c) The person has not been granted a license.

5 (2) A person's exemption under subsection (1) expires when the  
6 person's application under section 1e is no longer pending  
7 department approval.

8 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect  
9 unless all of the following bills of the 103rd Legislature are  
10 enacted into law:
