SENATE BILL NO. 493

August 12, 2025, Introduced by Senators POLEHANKI and CAMILLERI and referred to Committee on Education.

A bill to amend 1979 PA 94, entitled
"The state school aid act of 1979,"

(MCL 388.1601 to 388.1896) by adding section 31c.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 31c. (1) From the state school aid fund money
- 2 appropriated in section 11, there is allocated for 2025-2026 only
- 3 an amount not to exceed \$65,000,000.00 for grants to eligible
- 4 districts for pilot programs to maintain or establish small classes
- 5 in grades K to 3 in eligible school buildings in the district.
- 6 (2) To be eligible for a grant under subsection (1), a

- 1 district must have at least 1 eligible school building and must
- 2 apply to the department in the form and manner prescribed by the
- 3 department. A district shall include in its application a projected
- 4 budget for maintaining or establishing small classes in grades K to
- 5 3 and shall demonstrate in the projected budget that at least 30%
- 6 of the funds received by the district under section 31a will be
- 7 used to support small classes under this section.
- 8 (3) For a school building to be considered an eligible school
- 9 building under subsection (2), the school building must meet all of
- 10 the following requirements:
- 11 (a) Operate at least 1 of grades K to 3.
- 12 (b) Be operated by a district that operates all of grades K to
- 13 12 and that receives funds under section 31a.
- 14 (c) Be located in a district that is in an opportunity index
- 15 band, as described in section 31a, of 4 or higher.
- 16 (4) Not more than 25% of the total allocation under this
- 17 section may be paid to any single district. The department shall
- 18 make allocations under this section to districts that are
- 19 geographically diverse, including urban, suburban, and rural
- 20 districts. Grants issued under this section must be awarded to at
- 21 least the following districts:
- 22 (a) Muskegon Heights Public School Academy System.
- 23 (b) Benton Harbor Area Schools.
- 24 (c) Flint School District.
- 25 (d) Wayne-Westland Community School District.
- 26 (5) A district that receives funds under this section shall
- 27 use the funds to maintain or establish small classes in grades K to
- 28 3 in school buildings of the district for which funds are received
- 29 under this section. The average class size must be not more than 17

- 1 pupils per class, with not more than 19 pupils in any particular
- 2 class. A district that receives funds under this section shall use
- 3 at least 30% of the funds the district receives for 2025-2026 under
- 4 section 31a for the purposes of this section.
- 5 (6) Funding to districts under this section for 2025-2026 is 6 intended to be for the first of 2 years of funding.
- 7 (7) The funds allocated in this section are a work project
- 8 appropriation, and any unexpended funds for 2025-2026 are carried
- 9 forward into 2026-2027. The purpose of the work project is to lower
- 10 class sizes in grades K to 3. The estimated completion date of the
- 11 work project is September 30, 2030.
- 12 (8) Notwithstanding section 17b, the department shall make
- 13 payments under this section on a schedule determined by the
- 14 department.
- 15 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 16 unless Senate Bill No. (request no. S02998'25) of the 103rd
- 17 Legislature is enacted into law.
