

**MICHIGAN ELECTION LAW (EXCERPT)**  
**Act 116 of 1954**

**168.970g Candidate receiving highest number of votes; election.**

Sec. 970g. The candidate receiving the highest number of votes in the recall general election is elected for the remainder of the term.
