- Sec. 5. (1) "Law enforcement agency" means that term as defined in section 682 of the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.682.
- (2) "Motor bus" means bus and "motor carrier of passengers" means motor carrier as those terms are defined in section 3 of the motor bus transportation act, 1982 PA 432, MCL 474.103.
- (3) "Nonpublic school" means that term as defined in section 5 of the revised school code, 1976 PA 451, MCL 380.5.
- (4) "Public school" means that term as defined in section 5 of the revised school code, 1976 PA 451, MCL 380.5.
- (5) "Rule" means a rule promulgated pursuant to the administrative procedures act of 1969, 1969 PA 306, MCL 24.201 to 24.328.
 - (6) "School" means either a public school or a nonpublic school, or both.
- (7) "School district" means that term as defined in section 6 of the revised school code, 1976 PA 451, MCL 380.6.
- (8) "Stop-arm camera system" means a system of 2 or more cameras affixed to a school bus that meets all of the following requirements:
- (a) Is synchronized to automatically record video or 1 or more sequenced photographs of a vehicle that fails to stop for a school bus or passes a school bus in violation of section 682(1) of the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.682.
 - (b) Is capable of capturing images of all of the following:
 - (i) The vehicle.
 - (ii) The registration plate on the rear of the vehicle.
 - (iii) A distance of not less than 200 feet in front of the school bus.
 - (c) Records the date, time, and location on a video recorded or photograph captured by the system.
