257.1820 Stop-arm camera system; agreement with law enforcement agencies.

Sec. 20. (1) A school bus may be equipped with a stop-arm camera system in accordance with this section.

- (2) A school district may do any of the following:
- (a) Install and operate a stop-arm camera system on a school bus.
- (b) Enter into an agreement with 1 or more law enforcement agencies that establishes enforcement responsibilities for and the reimbursement of any costs related to a camera-based violation of section 682(1) of the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.682.
 - (c) Enter into a contract with a private vendor to do 1 or more of the following:
 - (i) Install, operate, and provide support to a stop-arm camera system on a school bus.
- (ii) Perform the school district's obligations under an agreement described in subdivision (b) on behalf of the school district.
- (3) If required by a contract entered into under subsection (2), a private vendor operating a stop-arm camera system shall provide all of the following information to a law enforcement agency authorized to enforce section 682(1) of the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.682, if the stop-arm camera system captures a photograph or records video showing an alleged violation of section 682(1) of the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.682:
 - (a) A copy of the photograph captured or video recorded showing the motor vehicle.
 - (b) The registration plate number and state of issuance of the registration plate.
 - (c) The date, time, and place of the alleged violation.
