

MICHIGAN SCHOOL FOR THE BLIND (EXCERPT)
Act 123 of 1893

393.101 School for blind; maintenance.

Sec. 1. That there shall be maintained, at the city of Lansing, in this state, an institution for the instruction of the blind under the name and style of the "Michigan school for the blind."
