

RAILROAD CODE OF 1993 (EXCERPT)
Act 354 of 1993

462.267 Light or banner attached to switch or derailing device; prohibited conduct; violation as misdemeanor; penalty.

Sec. 267. (1) A person not authorized by a railroad company shall not destroy, remove, change, extinguish, or tamper with any light or banner attached to or connected with any switch or derailing device maintained by a railroad company.

(2) A person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not less than \$100.00 or more than \$500.00 or by imprisonment for not more than 60 days.
