552.2711 Modification of foreign Convention child-support order.

- Sec. 711. (1) A tribunal of this state may not modify a Convention child-support order if the obligee remains a resident of the foreign country where the support order was issued unless 1 of the following applies:
- (a) The obligee submits to the jurisdiction of a tribunal of this state, either expressly or by defending on the merits of the case without objecting to the jurisdiction at the first available opportunity.
- (b) The foreign tribunal lacks or refuses to exercise jurisdiction to modify its support order or issue a new support order.
- (2) If a tribunal of this state does not modify a Convention child-support order because the order is not recognized in this state, section 708(3) applies.
