

UNIFORM UNCLAIMED PROPERTY ACT (EXCERPT)
Act 29 of 1995

567.237 Property held in safe deposit box or repository.

Sec. 17. Except as otherwise provided in section 17a, all property held in a safe deposit box or any other safekeeping repository in this state in the ordinary course of the holder's business and proceeds resulting from the sale of the property permitted by law, that remain unclaimed by the owner for more than 3 years after the lease or rental period on the box or other repository has expired, are presumed abandoned.

Compiler's note: Enacting section 1 of Act 197 of 2010 provides:

Enacting section 1 of Act 101 of 2024 provides:

"Enacting section 1. This amendatory act applies to property that is presumed abandoned and subject to this state's custody as unclaimed property on or after the effective date of this amendatory act."
