FAMILY CHILD CARE NETWORKS ACT (EXCERPT) Act 108 of 2022

722.1615 Department duties; annual report.

Sec. 15. (1) The department shall do, at a minimum, all of the following:

- (a) Upon appropriation, establish a family child care network in every region of this state.
- (b) Require all networks to participate in the following:
- (i) A statewide community of practice.
- (ii) Professional development for network staff.
- (iii) Data collection and evaluation to measure success and improve the networks' responsiveness to providers.
- (c) Require networks to be connected to the state's existing child care infrastructure, including, at least, the state's quality and licensing system.
- (2) The department shall submit an annual report on the activities and outcomes of each family child care network by region and the changes in the number of home-based providers in the state to the house and senate appropriation committees on the department budget and the state budget office.
