285.222 Agricultural tourism advisory commission; creation; membership; service; vacancy; removal

Sec. 2. (1) The agricultural tourism advisory commission is created within the department.

- (2) The commission shall consist of the following members appointed by the director:
- (a) Four individuals representing agricultural tourism enterprises.
- (b) Two individuals representing, or from an association representing, local units of government.
- (c) One individual representing the travel Michigan division of the Michigan economic development corporation.
- (d) One individual representing a convention bureau, visitors bureau, or chamber of commerce in a rural area.
 - (e) One individual representing the department.
- (3) The members first appointed to the commission shall be appointed within 60 days after the effective date of this act.
 - (4) Members of the commission shall serve for the life of the commission.
 - (5) If a vacancy occurs on the commission, the director shall make an appointment to fill the vacancy.
- (6) A member of the commission may be removed by the director, for incompetency, dereliction of duty, malfeasance, misfeasance, or nonfeasance in office, or any other good cause.
