Act 350 of 1980

550.1473 Medicare supplement certificate; definitions and terms.

Sec. 473. A health care corporation certificate shall not be titled, advertised, solicited, or issued for delivery in this state as a medicare supplement certificate unless the definitions and terms contained in the certificate are such that covered benefits under the certificate are not more restrictive than covered benefits under medicare and those required to be provided under state law. A medicare supplement certificate shall contain a definition of medicare as that term is defined in section 451 or substantially similar to that definition.
